- 1. An Editor-in-Chief remains on the editorial board for four years, and then renewed for another four years. This assignment is likely to continue for an indefinite period of time.
- 2. An editor can contribute in many ways to improve the book. Contributions include, but notlimited to the following:
- (i) Contributing problems and solutions
- (ii) Assessing / editing new material
- (iii) Arranging and ordering material in chapters / book
- (iv) Giving direction to improve the book
- (v) Editor-in-Chief may wish to invite other editors
- (vi) Collaborating with other editors
- (vii) Any other work related to the book
- 3. All editors get free access to the book.
- 4. The Editor-in-Chief receives 10% of the amount sold.
- 5. Editor-in-Chief becomes the Current Editor
- 6. Book is uploaded at the end of the year as per revision and advises of the Editor-in-Chief.
- 7. Editorship is an on-going and informal process.
- 8. Study matter in part or full may be reproduced anywhere including magazine and other books.
- 9. Guidelines are updated from time to time, without giving any notice.
